




## **AIM**

## **ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND SOFT SKILL ENHANCEMENT SYSTEM**

English being important and essential, it was decided by the Management to set up a language lab. The College provides a soft skill enhancement program through Skillphones and English Learning Station which paves the way for the students to learn and speak the language effectively.

### **ID CARD**

Each student will be issued an identity card with the signature of the Principal. This identity card can be used for 3 years. They must produce their identity cards when the Principal or Head or any other staff member demands them for verification.

If any student has not been issued an ID card or loses it, he can get the same from the College office by producing a passport size photo and the amount for the ID card.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** NSS / NCC / Physical Education

As per the regulation of the Bharathiar University, Every student shall participate compulsorily for a period of not less than two years (4 semesters) in any one of the above programmes.

The above activities shall be conducted outside the regular working hours of the college. The Principal shall furnish a certificate regarding the students' performance in the respective field and shall grade the student in five point scale as follows:

This grading shall be incorporated in the mark sheet to be issued at the end of the appropriate semester. Handicapped students who are unable to participate in the above activities shall be required to take a test in the theoretical aspect of any one of the above fields and be certified accordingly.

Students who are interested can become the members of the National Service Scheme (NSS) Programme. As per the university norms, enrolled students must do social service for 120 hours in a year. They will be issued a Certificate.

## **LIBRARY**

1. The Library is common for the staff and the students.
2. Students can borrow books for the semester concerned on all working days.
3. Only 3 books can be borrowed by every U.G. student & 5 books by P. G. student.
4. No student can retain the book for a period exceeding 15 days.
5. Students who return books after the due date will be levied a penalty of Rs.10 per Week.
6. Students should return all the books taken from the library 10 days before the issue of Hall tickets in the respective semester.
7. Hall tickets will not be issued unless the books are returned to the library.
8. Librarian or Head of the Department may instruct the students to return the books before the due date.
9. Students must not sub-lend and must not return books other than what he has borrowed.
10. In case of damage or loss, new books should be replaced. If a book is not available, the cost of the book with fine will be collected.
11. In case of loss of Library Card, students may get duplicate card by paying penalty.
12. While borrowing books, students must check the correctness of pages. Similarly while returning them, if a book is torn, the student who has borrowed it must take responsibility for that.
13. Under Book Bank Scheme, SC/ST & economically poor students are given books for reading & reference.

## **READING HALL**

1. Reading hall will be opened from 9 a.m. to 3.30 p.m.
2. Strict silence must be maintained inside the reading hall.
3. Students must take the weekly and monthly magazines for reading only after signing.
4. Boys must not enter sections separated for the Staff and Girls.
5. Damage or loss of books and journals must be reimbursed by the students.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE**

1. Students should understand the importance of instruction in classes and should pay utmost attention to it.
2. Students must behave properly in the campus and should bring credit and honor to themselves and the Institution.
3. Students should wear formal and tidy dresses.
4. They should not stamp their feet on the walls.
5. Girls must proceed from their lunch shed to their class rooms silently only at the stroke of the first bell.
6. Students must occupy their seats in their respective classrooms at the stroke of the first bell.
7. Students must stand up when the staff enters the classroom as a mark of respect and greet him/her.
8. Students must not stand outside the class room or anywhere around the college campus after the first bell.
9. Late comers must meet the Principal and they must stay in the library till the first hour is over.
10. After lunch break, students should return immediately to their classrooms. They should avoid going late to the classrooms.
11. Students should not go outside the class without the permission of the staff.
12. During working hours students should not go out of the class for paying college fee or for borrowing books from the library.
13. Students must not enter the office, staff room and lab without permission.
14. College property must not be damaged at any cost.
15. Writing on the walls or on the table or damaging the property of the college is a serious offence. Students have to pay the penalty fee, if they violate these instructions.
16. Students should not act against the educational rules of Tamilnadu Government. If they violate the law they will be liable to any one of the following punishments  
A. Imposition of fine    B. Suspension    C. Expulsion
17. Decision taken by the principal is final in the case of students who violate the rules and regulations of the college.

## **LAB RULES**

1. Both boys and girls should maintain silence and discipline inside the computer lab.
2. Students will be permitted to appear for University practical examination only when they satisfactorily complete the practical test and model practical examination.
3. Students must handle the lab equipment carefully. In case any damage or loss occurs, the students should bear the cost and the fine imposed by the Principal.

## **HOSTEL RULES**

1. Hostel functions under the direct control of the warden. He will function as per the instructions of the Secretary and Principal.
2. Complete silence should be maintained inside the hostel campus after 8.30 p.m.
3. No guests will be entertained inside the hostel
4. Inmates have to take their food in the respective time.  
Breakfast : 08.00 a.m.to 09.00 a.m.  
Lunch : 12.10 p.m.to 12.35 p.m.  
Tea : 03.40 p.m.to 05.00 p.m.  
Supper : 07.30 p.m. to 08.30 p.m.  
(Food will not be served after 8.30 p.m.)
5. Inmates should be inside the hostel before 6.00 p.m.
6. Smoking and consumption of alcohol are strictly prohibited.
7. Playing cards or indulging in unhealthy activities will result in dismissal from the hostel.
8. Boarding fee has to be paid within 7 days of the specified date, Students who fail to do so will not be permitted to take food.
9. Hostel property should not be damaged. Scribbling and unethical activities are prohibited. If any hostel property is damaged, the cost of the property will be collected from the inmates. Incase of no evidence the inmates should collectively bear the cost of the damaged property.

## **TUTORIAL SYSTEM**

1. Each student will be under the care of a staff (tutor). The tutor will monitor the academic performance and he/she will guide the student regarding studies, and college rules and regulations.
2. Leave forms, request letters must be forwarded to the HOD and to the Principal only through the tutor. The tutor will scrutinize the leave forms and requisitions and forward and recommend the same to the Head of the Department and the Principal. Besides, the same will be recorded in the register.
3. Students should meet their tutors regularly to get their advice and to get their doubts clarified.
4. A tutor must know about his wards and must keep in touch with his parents or guardians. He should inform them about the conduct and progress of their son / daughter if not in person at least by post.
5. A tutor must intimate regularly about his/her wards' performance and improvement to the Head of the Department, Principal and parents.
6. Personal information sheet must be filled and given to the tutor by the ward.
7. It is the duty of the tutor to give his / her recommendation in the application forms and for the issue of bonafide certificates. He will monitor the regularity of the student to the classes and will counsel the students.
8. All certificates issued by the Principal will only be based on the recommendation of the tutor.

## **COLLEGE FEE PAYMENT**

- ❖ Students shall pay the fees within 10 days from the first working day of a semester. If they fail to pay within the specified date their names will be removed from the nominal roll.

## **ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE**

1. According to the University norms the minimum working days per semester is 90. Only students with **75 % of attendance** will be permitted to appear for the University Examinations.
2. Students who fail to secure **75 % of attendance** are not eligible to appear for the University Examination.
3. Students who have attendance below **75 % and above 64 % have** to pay condonation fee with the permission of the Principal.
4. Candidates who have attendance between **50% and 64% are not** eligible to write the examination in the current semester, but are permitted to continue their studies in the next semester. However, these candidates are eligible to write arrear subjects, if any.
5. Students who secure **below 50 % of attendance** will not be permitted to continue their studies in the next semester. **They have to re-do the course in the next academic year.**
6. To write university examination and to obtain attendance certificate, the academic performance and conduct should be satisfactory to the Principal and staff.
7. Only if the conduct and performance in studies of students are satisfactory, they will be permitted to write University Examinations and will Hall Tickets be issued to them.
8. Students should write well their monthly tests / CIA tests and model exams conducted by the college to earn high percentage of marks in Internal Assessment.
9. Students who want to take leave should submit their leave letter and get prior permission from the Head of the Department.
10. Leave letter should be written in the given format and it should reach the HOD through the tutor.
11. Medical certificate should be produced if the period of leave exceeds more than three days.
12. Students who take leave for more than a week must get prior permission from the Principal. Parents should compulsorily meet the Principal and get permission if the student is unable to report.
13. Names of the students who take leave without intimation for a long period will be removed from the nominal roll.
